How a Stitchdoodles SAL works...

### Accessing the Tutorials:

- A Stitchdoodles SAL is based solely on the Stitchdoodles Blog - when a SAL is live - you can access all the tutorials online on the blog.
- You can access the tutorial from the home page of the blog - it will be the latest post at the top on the day it is released. Go to [www.stitchdoodles.com](http://www.stitchdoodles.com)
- You will not be able to download or print the instructions - they are intended to be followed on an online device so please bear this in mind when purchasing
- Each Wednesday for the duration of the SAL, the tutorial will be live on the stitchdoodles blog around 8am UK time.
- The SAL lasts for a certain amount of weeks, after this the tutorials remain on the blog so you can access and stitch the design in your own time if you did not manage to keep up.

### Your stitching Experience:

- Everyone is welcome to join in a SAL regardless of your level of stitching experience.
- The SAL is not a 'How to' guide for individual stitches - it is expected you will use your own knowledge or research on how to do individual stitches to complete the different elements.
- The Whole pattern is released in stages so it is not possible to have all the instructions prior to the SAL finish date.
- You will NOT receive a pattern booklet with the kit. When purchased as a SAL, the kit is to be used alongside the online tutorials on the blog.

Once the SAL finishes, there will be a complete pattern of the design produced which is not included as part of the SAL. This is a separate product so please do not ask to be given this at the end if you have not completed or have not accessed the tutorials.

If you prefer to follow a Printed Pattern then please wait until the SAL has finished to purchase the design in a different format.
